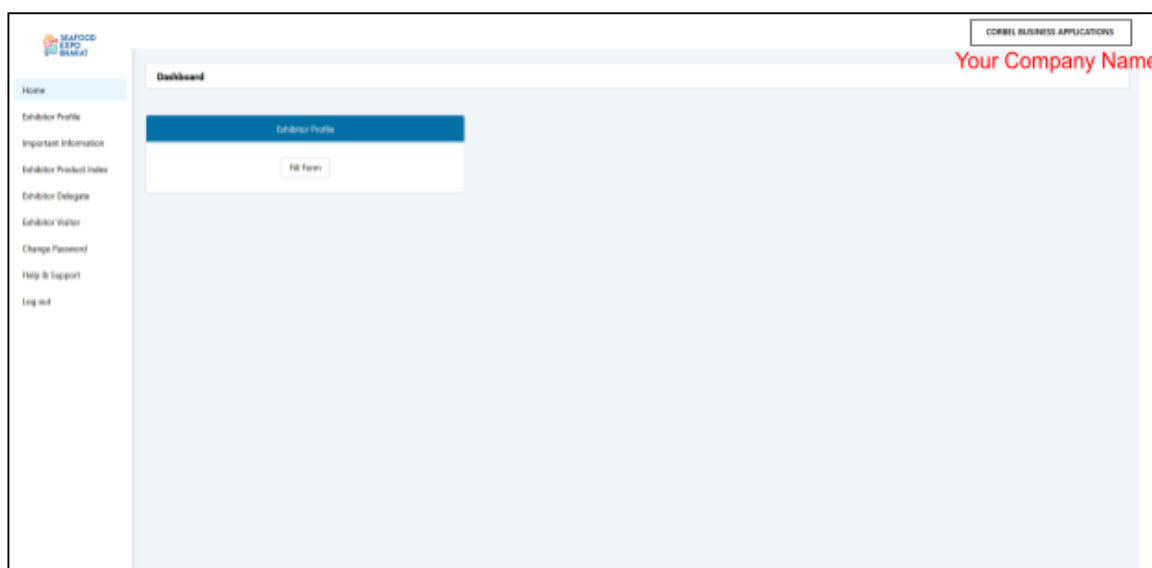

5. Admission

Admission is strictly regulated, and access will be provided only upon registration as Exhibitor /Delegate/ Visitor.

All the delegates, exhibitors, visitors, organizer officials, stall contractors and others have to produce the registration tags on the entry to the security personnels and on request of any of the organizer officials or security personnels.

Children below the age of 18 years will not be allowed inside the exhibition halls.

Students above the age 18 years will be permitted inside the exhibition halls as visitors / delegates with entry passes issued on the production of Original Institution ID cards.

EXHIBITOR BADGES- Exhibitor Badge is mandatory for all exhibitors and is required for entry to the exhibition hall, food court and technical sessions or any other exhibition area for all three days of the exhibition. Exhibitor badges can be collected from the registration desks at the venue. The registration desks at the venue will open at 08:00 am on 01 June 2026.

6. Deadline to stop stall erecting work.

The stall/booths has to be finished in all respects and be ready by **07:00 AM, 01 July 2026**.

- Heavy machinery must be moved in before **03:00 PM on 29th June 2026**.
- Raw space exhibitors can commence moving in their materials and setting up their stalls on **29th of June 2026, 10:00 AM**.
- Last date for completion of fabrication of custom- made stall is **30th June 2026 by 07:00 PM**.
- Shell scheme stalls will be handed over on **30th June 2026 from 02:00 PM onwards**.
- All exhibitors shall complete the stall set up by **07:00 PM on 30th June 2026**.

Entry to the venue will be allowed only to the exhibitors, official booth contractors, third party stall contractors and their personnel from 29th to 30th June 2026.

7. Dismantling and removal of Exhibits

Exhibitors are allowed to remove the exhibits from the booths only after the official closure of the exhibition (i.e., after 04:00 PM on 3rd June 2026).

Goods may be taken out only on receipt of Exit Pass. Stall contractor will issue exit passes to the exhibitors.

8. Electricity

Standard basic power will be provided with the stall.

Exhibitors requiring heavy electrical load / compressed air for their exhibits should submit such requirements to the organizers by **22nd June 2026**.

Additional power required by the exhibitor will be charged.

11. Custom built Stall (Raw space)

Approval: Stalls having area 18 sq.m and above opting for custom built stall need to intimate the stall contractor regarding the height permissions of their stalls and get the approval in advance.

All Exhibitors opting for their own design, should submit details of the contractor, layout plan and design prototype to the organizers by **22nd June 2026** for approval.

12. Exhibitor's Name on fascia

Exhibitor's name, as given at the time of registration for the event, will be put on fascia with pre-cut lettering of standard size. Depending on the length of the fascia, standard abbreviations will be used.

13. Amendments to Regulations

The Organiser reserve the right to issue amendments / additions to the rules & regulations, if required. The Organiser reserve the right to issue amendments / additions to the rules & regulations, if required.

14. Terms and conditions for exhibitors

14.1 General

- 14.1.1 Seafood Expo Bharat (SEB) 2026 shall be organized by MPEDA at Chennai Trade Centre, Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India from 01–03 July 2026. The grand opening of the exhibition will be at 10:00 am on 1st July 2026 in Chennai Trade Center, Chennai, India.
- 14.1.2 Registration for the space should be made online. Submission of an application for participation shall constitute acceptance of the Exhibit Space Contract Form, Exhibitor Manual, these Terms and Conditions and any instructions issued by the Organizer. The exhibition manual available on the Website: www.seafoodexpobharat.com
- 14.1.3 The Organizer reserves the right to accept or reject any application for participation without assigning any reason.
- 14.1.4 The Organizer reserves the right to alter stall locations, floor plans, hall layouts, traffic flow arrangements or exhibition configurations in the interest of safety, operational requirements or efficient conduct of the exhibition.
- 14.1.5 Participation shall be restricted to bona fide organizations engaged in seafood, fisheries, aquaculture and allied sectors as determined by the Organizer.
- 14.1.6 Confirmation of Stall reservations will be sent by E-mail/message.

14.2 Participation Fees and Payment

- 14.2.1 Participation fees shall be payable as notified by the Organizer and shall be exclusive of applicable GST.
- 14.2.2 For the stall registration within Tamil Nadu, the GST should be in SGST(9%)& CGST(9%), whereas for the stalls outside Tamil Nadu, it should be IGST(18%).
- 14.2.3 All payments shall be made within the time stipulated by the Organizer
- 14.2.4 Failure to make payment within the stipulated period may result in cancellation of the stall allocation without prejudice to the Organizer's rights.
- 14.2.5 Fees paid shall be non-refundable.

14.3 Cancellation and No-Show

- 14.3.1 Requests for cancellation shall be submitted in writing to the Organizer.
- 14.3.2 No cancellation shall be accepted after 15th of June 2026.
- 14.3.3 Failure to occupy the allotted stall by 09:00 hours on 01 July 2026 shall be treated as a no-show and the booking shall stand cancelled without refund.
- 14.3.4 Participation shall not be transferable to future editions of the exhibition.

14.4 Stall Allocation and Use

- 14.4.1 Stall allocation shall be at the sole discretion of the Organizer.
- 14.4.2 The allotted stall shall not be transferred, assigned, sublet or shared with any third party without prior written approval of the Organizer.
- 14.4.3 The stall shall be used solely for exhibiting products, services and activities approved by the Organizer.
- 14.4.4 All displays, demonstrations and promotional activities shall remain within the boundaries of the allotted stall.

14.5 Stall Construction and Operations

- 14.5.1 Exhibitors shall strictly adhere to move-in, installation, operation and dismantling schedules notified by the Organizer.
- 14.5.2 For bare scheme (raw space), the stall will be handed over to the Exhibitors on 29th of June at 10:00 AM and for the shell scheme, the stall will be handed over to the Exhibitor on 30/06/2026 by 02:00 PM. The stall once allotted is not transferable.
- 14.5.3 Exhibitors opting for raw space shall obtain prior approval for stall designs and layouts.
- 14.5.4 No Exhibitor will be permitted to install exhibits or displays in such a manner as, in the sole opinion of the Organizers, obstructs the light or impedes the view along open spaces. The passage must be kept clear and must not be littered or obstructed in any way.
- 14.5.5 No nails, screws, bolts, or other fixtures may be driven into any part of the Venue, including floors. Nor may any part of the venue be damaged or disfigured in any way. If any damages occur, the Exhibitor responsible shall be directly liable for any reparation charges incurred by the venue owners.
- 14.5.6 The Exhibitor shall be liable to pay for any damages caused to the stall or equipment allotted to him. Any such damage shall be assessed by the organizers and their decision on the charges to be paid by the exhibitor shall be final.
- 14.5.7 The stall shall remain adequately staffed during official exhibition hours.
- 14.5.8 No dismantling or removal of exhibits shall commence prior to the official closure of the exhibition.

14.6 Promotion and Advertising

- 14.6.1 Exhibitors must not canvas or distribute advertising or promotional matter in any part of the venue, except near their stands/stalls.
- 14.6.2 An Exhibitor must undertake to withdraw any advertising matter at the Exhibition to which the Organizers may reasonably object on the grounds of legality, decency, or honesty, nor may use any audio-visual system that would in the opinion of the Organizers cause annoyance or disturbance to others.

- 14.6.3 Special demonstrations, cultural performances or entertainment activities within the booth is to be limited within the scope of the show, that too with prior permission from the organizer.

14.7 Food Sampling and Product Demonstrations

- 14.7.1 Distribution of food products, seafood samples and beverages shall require prior approval from the Organizer.
- 14.7.2 The Exhibitor shall comply with all applicable food safety, hygiene and public health regulations.
- 14.7.3 Waste generated from such activities shall be disposed of in accordance with venue and statutory requirements.

14.8 Prohibited Activities

- 14.8.1 Storage or use of hazardous, explosive, inflammable or dangerous materials without approval is prohibited.
- 14.8.2 Obstruction of aisles, emergency exits, fire-fighting equipment or common areas is prohibited.
- 14.8.3 Display or dissemination of unlawful, offensive, obscene, defamatory or politically sensitive material is prohibited.
- 14.8.3 Misuse or unauthorized transfer of exhibitor badges, passes or credentials is prohibited.
- 14.8.3 Any activity contrary to applicable laws, venue regulations or Organizer instructions is prohibited.

14.9 Intellectual Property and Branding

- 14.9.1 The name, logo, emblem, trademark or branding of MPEDA or Seafood Expo Bharat shall not be used without prior written permission.
- 14.9.2 Exhibitors shall ensure that exhibits, displays and promotional materials do not infringe any intellectual property rights of third parties.
- 14.9.3 Any liability arising from intellectual property infringement shall be borne solely by the Exhibitor.

14.10 Safety, Security and Insurance

- 14.10.1 Exhibitors shall comply with all safety requirements prescribed by the Organizer, venue authorities and statutory authorities.
- 14.10.2 Exhibitors are advised to obtain adequate insurance coverage for personnel, exhibits, equipment and third-party liabilities.
- 14.10.3 The Organizer may require proof of insurance wherever considered necessary.
- 14.10.4 The Organizer shall not be responsible for theft, loss or damage to exhibits or exhibitor property.

14.11 Damage to Property

- 14.11.1 The Exhibitor shall be responsible for any damage caused by its personnel, contractors, agents or representatives to venue property or exhibition infrastructure.
- 14.11.2 The assessment of damages made by the Organizer and/or venue authority shall be final and binding.

14.12 Liability and Indemnity

- 14.12.1 Participation in the exhibition shall be entirely at the Exhibitor's risk.
- 14.12.2 The Organizer shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential or special loss arising out of participation in the exhibition.
- 14.12.3 The Exhibitor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Organizer, venue authorities and their personnel against all claims, damages, liabilities, losses and expenses arising out of the Exhibitor's participation.

14.13 Force Majeure

- 14.13.1 The Organizer reserves the right to postpone, curtail, relocate, reschedule or cancel the exhibition due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.
- 14.13.2 Such circumstances shall include natural disasters, war, terrorism, pandemics, epidemics, civil disturbances, governmental restrictions, strikes or any other force majeure event.
- 14.13.3 The Organizer shall not be liable for losses suffered by exhibitors as a result of such events.

14.14 Amendments

14.14.1 The Organizer reserves the right to amend, modify, supplement or interpret these Terms and Conditions whenever necessary.

14.14.2 Such amendments shall become binding upon notification to exhibitors.

14.15 Dispute Resolution and Jurisdiction

14.15.1 Any dispute arising out of participation in the exhibition shall first be resolved through mutual consultation.

14.15.2 Failing such resolution, disputes shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments thereto.

14.15.3 The seat and venue of arbitration shall be Ernakulam, Kerala.

14.15.4 Subject to arbitration, courts at Ernakulam, Kerala shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

14.16 Residual Matters

14.16.1 In the event of any matter not specifically covered in these Terms and Conditions, the decision of the Organizer shall be final and binding.

14.16.2 The Organizer shall at all times retain control over the exhibition premises and operational arrangements.

15. Fire Regulations & Precautions

In the common interest, co-operation of exhibitors is solicited to prevent fire or any other emergencies. All aisles and common areas must be kept free of obstacles. Exhibitors, who, because of the nature of their exhibits require special kind of fire extinguishers, must make arrangements at their own cost for the provision of such equipment. All electrical wirings, fittings etc. will be done strictly by the certified authorised electrical contractors only. Storage / Use of inflammable item are strictly prohibited. Exhibitors are requested to refrain from smoking within the exhibition premises. Any person seeing an outbreak of fire, (if any) must raise an immediate alarm and make all efforts to extinguish the same with the nearby extinguishers and inform the authorities. Also participants must make efforts to remove inflammable items from the vicinity.

16. Removal of Exhibits

Exhibitors can prepare to pack their exhibits into transportable form/packages from 04:00 PM to 06.00 PM on 3rd of June 2026, and complete the formality of entering particulars of the official Staff of the Exhibitor with the security before leaving the venue.

Goods may be taken out only on receipt of Exit Pass. Stall contractor will issue exit passes to the exhibitors.

17. Observance of Rules & Regulations

All Exhibitors and all their personnel must observe the Rules & Regulations stated in this Exhibitor Manual under 'Section II' while working or present in the Exhibition Hall area.

18. Safety & Behaviour

All exhibitors and crew members are requested to carry government notified cards- i.e Aadhaar card or PAN Card. No person present inside the exhibition hall is expected to behave or act in a manner that may cause any harm, injury or damage to other persons or exhibits, venue/ property, the exhibition hall property or fixtures. Damages of any kind caused by such staff members of the exhibitor or their contractors would attract monetary compensation as set by venue authorities or organiser.

19. Property security of the exhibitor

While the organiser will maintain general security surveillance at all times throughout the exhibition, the organiser cannot be held responsible for any theft / damage / loss of the exhibits or any other property of the exhibitor. Exhibitors are reminded that goods will be vulnerable immediately after the show closes on the final day. Please ensure to see that your stall(s) are not left unattended at this time. Particular care should be taken of small portable items, tools and instruments, including mobile phones. However, exhibitors are responsible for the organiser's properties (furnitures, fittings etc.) in the stalls and should be made available to them safely for removal.
